


How to Report a Safeguarding Concern in St Helens

Key Information When Reporting Adult Abuse in St Helens

WHO

- is the concern about?
- is involved in causing the abuse or neglect?

WHAT

- type of abuse?
- are the risks?
- are the relevant circumstances?
- What did the alleged perpetrator do or fail to do to the Adult
- Is the relationship between the alleged victim and alleged perpetrator

WHERE

- does the Adult live?
- does the alleged perpetrator live?
- did the alleged abuse occur?

WHEN

- did the alleged abuse occur? (date / time)
- was the concern first raised? (date/time)

Remember - WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN
